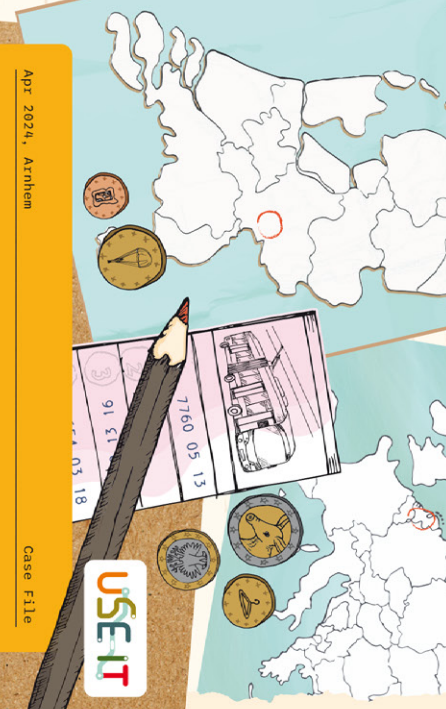

## Where can I find the tourist offices?

There is a citystore at the Elisabeth Kinderziekenhuis. It's open from Tuesday to Sunday, 10:00 to 17:00 and it's your go-to place for guides, maps and souvenirs. Warm welcome for Arnhem's war history! Try the more about Arnhem's war history at the Airborne at the Bridge office.

## How does public transport work?

The easiest way to use public transport is to get a debit card, which you can use to check in and out on both buses and trams. This doesn't work for all foreign cards though. In which case the next option is to get an over-shoulder check-in ticket machine. It's a top option is required system. A minimum amount of credit is needed to get you on a train. ## 1 A trip to the Middle-East

It is run by volunteers and opens in late spring, when the weather starts to get nice. You can lounge on the terrace or the beach in front of it, but it is also a great starting point for a hike over the floodplains.

## 3 Roller coffee

As you probably know, the Dutch are ultra-famous for building new land. They did this through pumping stations such as HET ARNHEMSE GEMAL, which still exists today and is now a characteristic cafe. You can view the old machinery inside while enjoying a cup of coffee and some apple pie or browse through a small vintage clothing store.

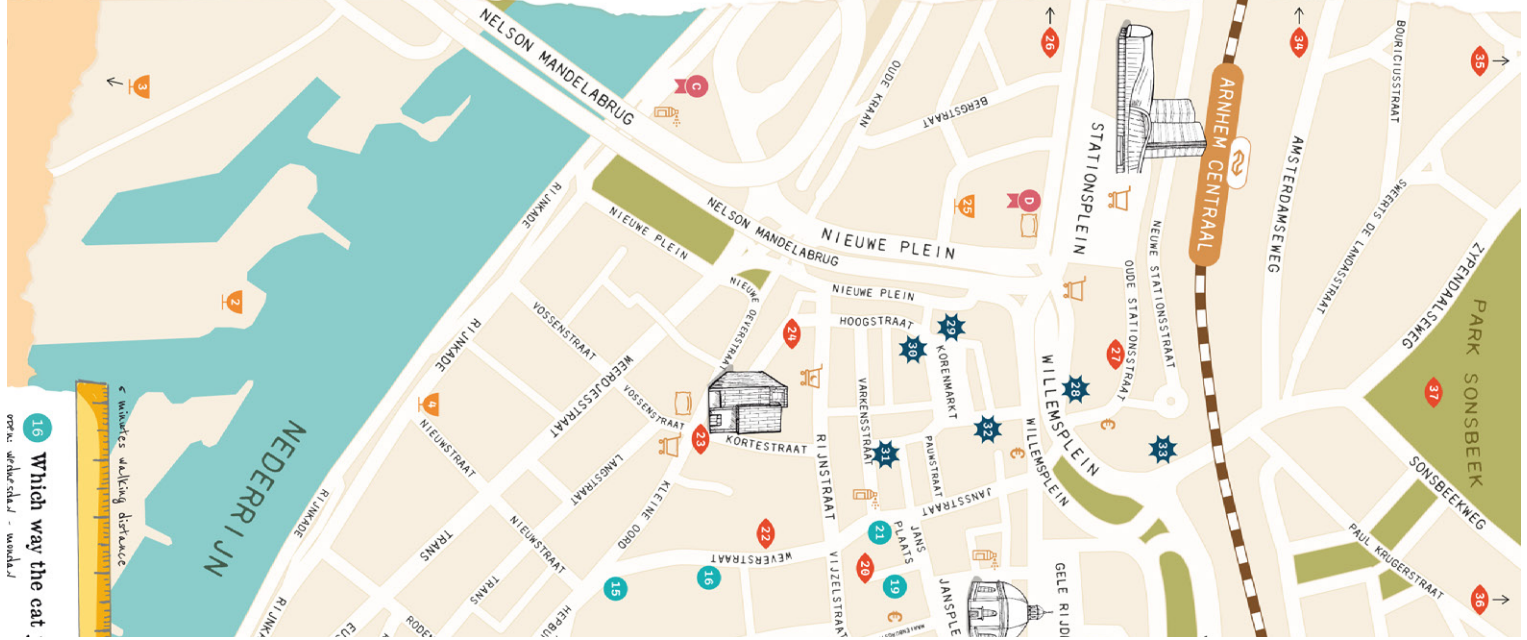

Arnhem's coziest bakery is and will always be HET ARNHEMSE BAKKERIE. The red facade and fairy tale letters on the windows draw you in like a fairytale gingerbread house. While they are most famous for their grofjes - a kind of curant bun - their other bread must certainly not be forgotten. The sourdough starter that they use is 22(!) years old and most of the bread is made by hand.

## 19 Watch your noodle

opke: Tuesday - Sunday

NOODLE WORKS has an open kitchen where you can see your food being prepared. From fresh Thai wok curries, rich noodle soups, to a wide range of fun side dishes. Both for vegetarians and meat lovers. Not unimportant: the prices are very tasty too.

## 20 Back alley billiards

opke: weekday - Sunday

hidden in a dark alley and only accessible via a questionably looking elevator, HOUSE OF BILLIARDS doesn't look like a place for fun, but it's actually a very destination for a fun and affordable night. The tables except the dining table, pool, snooker, foosball, pingpong, air hockey, you name it. For beginners and not-so-serious pool players we recommend playing €2,00 per game instead of €11,00 per hour.

## 21 The curry corner

opke: weekday - Sunday

The TANDOORI MASTER keeps returning on our map as a reliable place for an affordable Indian-Pakistani curry. If you didn't know it was there, you would likely have walked right past it. The curries make a good healthy meal, but you should also try their food menu from the tandoori oven. It's the best in town.

## 22 It's quite easy being green

## 23 A ludicrous library

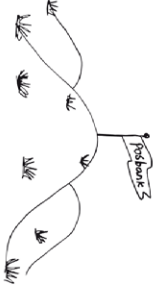

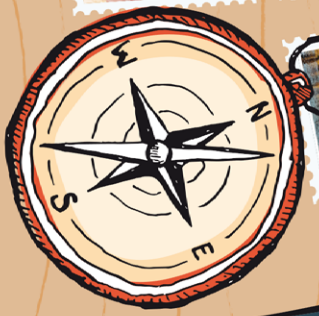

# 5 minutes of history

Arnhem is widely known for its World War II history. But, did you know that Arnhem has hidden medieval city centres behind some of its most famous streets? Discover the dark mysteries of the medieval city centre of Arnhem.

### Devil's House

In 1543 the infamous field marshal Marcell van Rossum turned his home into a neighbourhood in contrast to today, the Devil's House as he called it. He was a politician and a soldier.



### City basement

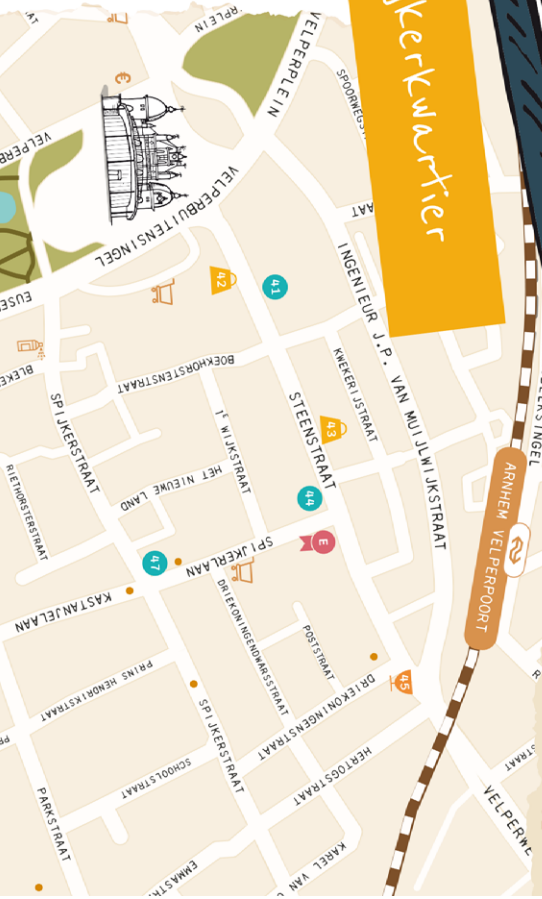


### Lunatics tower

### 445 Fresh from bean to cup

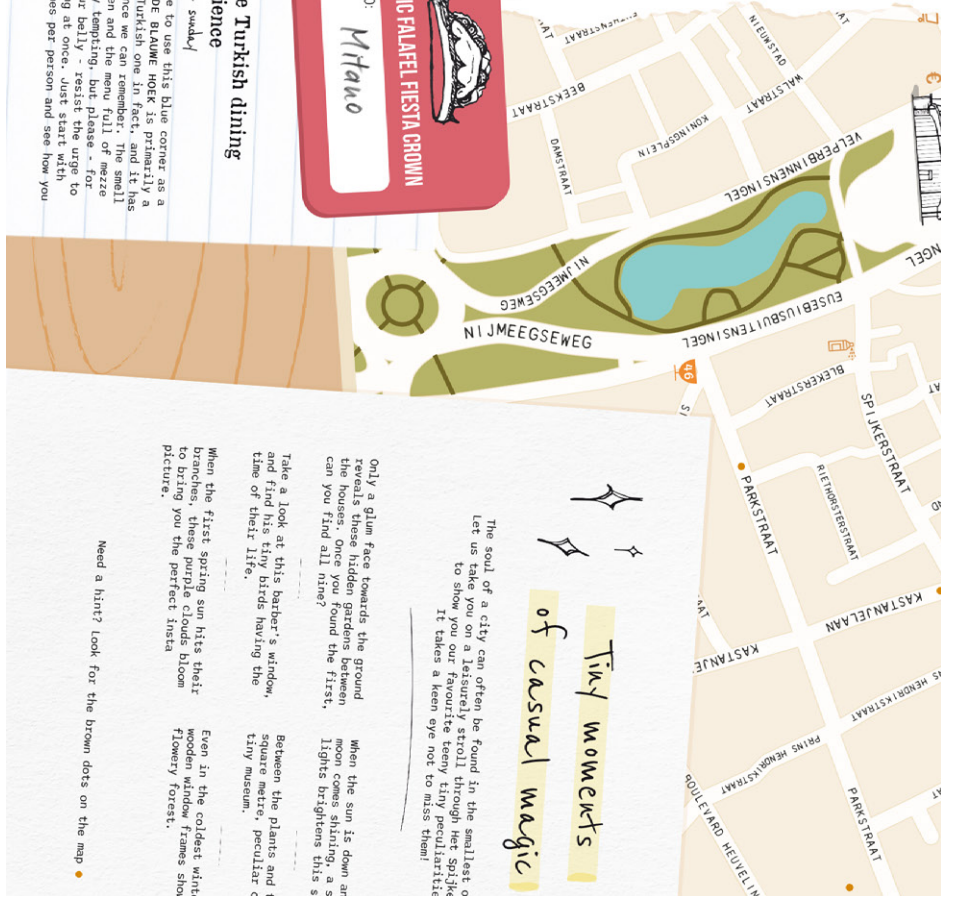

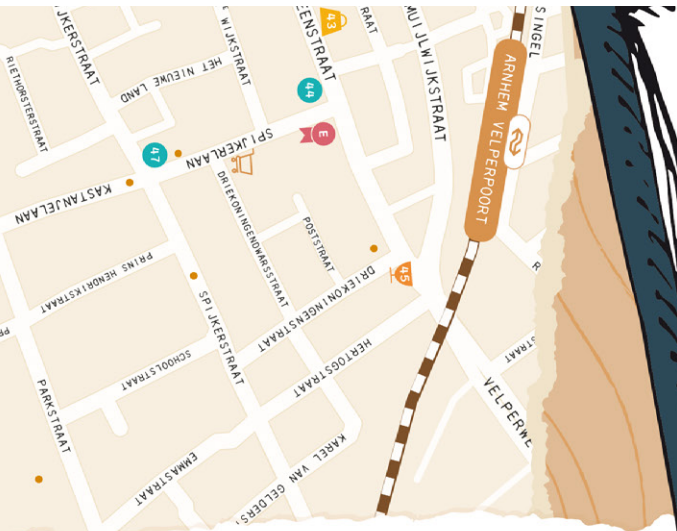


### Lunatics tower

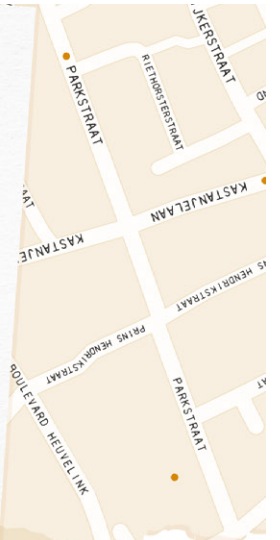
### 55 For the sweet tooth bakers
